The ideal candidates for our coaching positions must possess strong leadership skills, will enjoy being outside; be a self-starter; be enthusiastic; be motivated, high energy, and passionate about creating a cooperative hands-on learning atmosphere that engages the campers in learning while having FUN! The successful candidate must possess strong leadership skills. S/he must have a strong background in organizational, and communicational skills.

It is required that the individual applying for this position be a minimum of 21 years of age and hold a bachelor's degree in education, exercise science or facility management. It is preferred that the applicant have played in multiple competitive sports.

Our coaches are a critical part of CLKC Instructional Sport summer program success. Coaches will supervise, teach, and coach campers, play, and model strong faith-based character traits for ages 6-13 based on the designated curricula and scheduled special events of each themed week. CLKC's goal is to provide advanced instructional athletic development based on the individual needs of each child. The desire is to help children grow in knowledge, athletic skill, sportsmanship, and citizenship. As curricula is developed for sport ethics, coaching character, special events and more, the coach is responsible for providing complete coaching instructional plans for all athletic activities. In addition, the Coach would include central roles in organizing field events and athletic events.

Specific educational responsibilities include-

- Executing program planning, and project coordination with individual weekly sports
- Facilitating instruction and age-appropriate activities/instruction across all CLKC Instructional Sports fitness track
- Planning and coordinating resources for activities
- Participating in relevant or required training / professional development opportunities

Administrative and organizational responsibilities include-

- Strong leadership skills, and the ability to quickly respond to emergency situations
- Ensuring order by implementing disciplinary action based on CLKC policy and procedures
- Attending all CLKC's orientation and trainings (Open House event, orientation, safety and compliance)
- Upholding all CLKC policies and philosophy, and utilizing CLKC goals and objectives as a basis for working with one and all

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Ability to relate to a diverse range of people and exercise cultural competence and inclusion
- Strong work ethic and project management skills
